Contest Director Application Quiz

The use of common sense in the execution of a sanctioned event is very important. However, the most frequent cause for problems developing during an event is lack of knowledge by the Contest Director. This may be lack of knowledge of the *Competition Regulations*, *Membership Manual*, *Safety Code*, or event basic procedures. This short quiz identifies some areas that are very important, but all too often unknown or improperly done by Contest Directors. This is an open-book quiz. It is strongly suggested that you have a current copy of the *Competition Regulations*, *National Model Aircraft Safety Code*, *AMA Membership Manual*, and *Model Aviation* magazine for use in taking this quiz. A grade of 85% (you may miss no more than three questions) or greater is required to pass this quiz. Answers based on a non-current copy of the *Competition Regulations*, *National Model Aircraft Safety Code*, *AMA Membership Manual*, and *Model Aviation* magazine will be counted as incorrect if the current document indicates a different answer.
