

On Monday September 26<sup>th</sup>, The Culpeper Model Barnstormers (CMB) Radio Control aircraft club hosted the Culpeper Area Christian Home Educators (CACHE) at the Lenn Park's Lenn Model Airpark. About 20 CACHE home school students were given an introduction to radio controlled aircraft and multi-rotor helicopters, including their basic operation and characteristics. After these discussions, flight demonstrations of various fuel and electric powered aircraft were conducted by club members. Older students were given introductory flights on training planes and dual "buddy box" transmitters which allowed the students to fly the aircraft under the direct supervision of CMB flight instructors.
